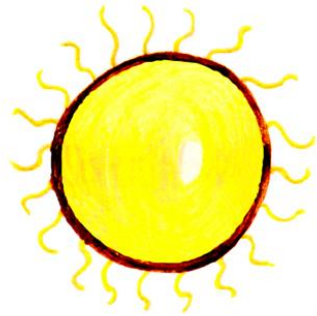
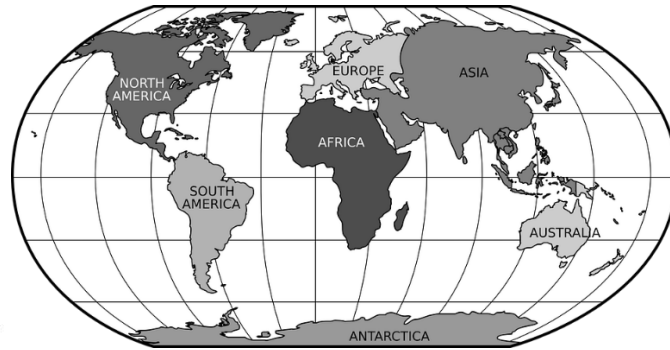


# Our World

Long o-silent e ( as in home )

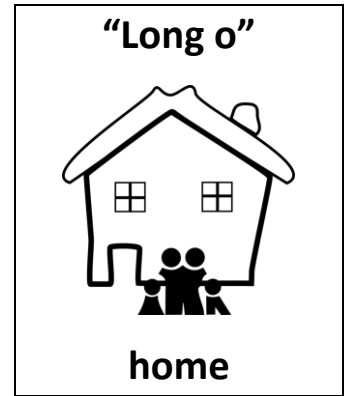
